The registered owner of the Exclusive Right of Burial has the automatic right to be buried in the grave or, to allow others to be buried in the grave (space permitting). No person can be buried in a grave and no memorial may be placed on the grave without the permission of the grave owner during the period of the Exclusive Rights of Burial. It is imperative that the ownership of the grave is checked at the time of making the booking and that your client is informed to contact us immediately if they do not have proof of ownership or permission from the owner. If an application is made for a burial in a grave where the registered owner is the deceased, or previously deceased, a transfer of the ownership will be required before the burial can be booked
