The registered owner of the Exclusive Right of Burial has the automatic right to be buried in the grave or to allow others to be buried in the grave (space permitting). No person can be buried in a grave and no memorial may be placed on the grave without the permission of the grave owner during the period of the Exclusive Rights of Burial. Newstead Parish Council may request proof of ownership or written permission from the owner. If an application is made for a burial in a grave where the registered owner is previously deceased, a transfer of the ownership will be required before the burial can take place.
